

**CHILLICOTHE MUNICIPAL UTILITIES  
RESIDENTIAL SERVICE  
Effective: 4/1/2025

AVAILABILITY

This schedule is available for residential service for dwellings used for domestic purposes. This schedule is not available for service through a single meter to multiple-family dwellings, rooming houses, etc., nor for service to two or more dwellings.

RATE

Customer Charge	\$35.00
Energy Charge-kWh	\$0.0950 per kWh

In addition to the above charges, a Net Energy Cost Adjustment charge will be added on a per kWh basis when necessary. See Net Energy Cost Adjustment Clause schedule for the current adder.

NET MINIMUM

The total net monthly bill, calculated as above, shall be not less than \$35.00 per month.

LATE PAYMENT

After twenty (20) days, a late fee is charged to any outstanding balance, and the account becomes subject to disconnection. Services disconnected for nonpayment will be restored upon payment of the past due amount, including late fee, plus a reconnection charge. The reconnection charge will be \$25.00 if the reconnection is made during regular business hours, Monday-Friday, 7:30 am - 4:30 pm, and \$50.00 if the reconnection is made after hours, Monday-Friday, between the hours of 4:30 pm and 8:00 pm. Any reconnection request after 8:00 pm will be completed the next business day during regular business hours. No reconnections will occur on a Saturday, Sunday, or an observed holiday.

PILOT FEE AND SALES TAX

In addition to the monthly rates computed above, the total monthly charge for service is subject to applicable sales tax and PILOT Fees. See Schedule A for the current PILOT rate.

## CONDITION OF SERVICE

1. Voltage, phase and frequency of energy supplied under this schedule shall be as specified by the City.
2. Service under this schedule shall be furnished for the sole use of the Customer and shall not be resold or sub-metered.
3. Service shall be supplied through a single meter unless authorized by the City. At the request of the Customer, separate meters may be retained, in which case each meter shall be billed as a separate customer.
4. Welding, x-ray, or other equipment characterized by severe or fluctuating demands, shall not be served under this schedule.
5. All motor driven devices of 1 ½ HP capacity or larger must be operated on a nominal voltage of 208 volts or higher. All permanently installed electric heating devices shall operate at 208 volts or higher.
6. All motors greater than 3 horsepower must be approved by CMU.
7. Service will be discontinued twenty (20) days after the date of a bill for nonpayment.
8. A reconnection fee will be charged to any customer requesting a meter be reconnected after it was shut-off due to nonpayment.
9. A connection fee will be charged to any customer requesting a meter to be reconnected at a service address not previously connected for the same customer.
